Hemocenters and centralization in Peru

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History

- Until 80's: Blood Banks of EsSalud (Peruvian Social Security) had to be prepared for giving support the transplant programs.
- 2000: Transfusion medicine services started to grow mostly in private Hospitals.
- 2004: First patient contaminated with HIV by transfusion.
- Government starts closing blood banks that do not meet standards. PRONAHEBAS has a main role on it.
